

## St. John's Early Learning Center Potty Training Policy

St. John's Early Learning Center is licensed to accept children aged 2 1/2 (30 months), who are potty trained.

A potty trained child is a child who can do the following:

- Child must be able to tell the adult that he/she needs to use the restroom. Child must be able to use words to clearly indicate to staff that he/she has to use the restroom.
- Child shall not wear one-piece outfits that require adult assistance to use the toilet.
- Child must be able to pull down his/her underwear and pants and pull them back up without assistance.
- Child must be able to wipe himself/herself.
- Child must wear underwear, not diapers or pull-ups.
- Child must have minimal (no more than 2 per week) accidents that require changing clothes.
- If a child has multiple accidents in a day or over a period of 3 days, this indicates the child is not fully toilet trained. Parents will be asked to keep the child home until they are completely toilet trained.
